**Question #1**

Please answer the following question with a yes or no.

In the last six months have you stopped beating your spouse?

**Discussion:** Was this a “fair” question?

**Question # 2**

Multiple-choice directions: Please choose A B or C for each of the following questions:

I am a \_\_\_\_\_?

- A) Fish
- B) Rock
- C) Plant

Discussion: If all the answers are wrong, is it “fair” to make you choose only between wrong answers? Does the fact that the correct answer is not there, make you think that you must be wrong? Perhaps, instead, it demonstrates that the teacher does not know the correct answer.

**Question # 3**

Please select at least one or more answers to the following question.

I will be sick

- A) Today
- B) Tomorrow
- C) In the future

**Discussion:** Can you be happy when all the answers make you sick?

**Question # 4**

Please select either answer A or B to the following question.

My existence will end \_\_\_\_\_.

- A) Today
- B) Sometime in the future

**Discussion:** Was it “fair” to assume that you agree that you are not eternal and therefore, that your existence must end?

Egoic questions are unfairly designed so that you can never rediscover your way home. The correct answer never appears as an allowed option and thus, the truth is kept hidden from your decision-maker. How can the decision-maker ever pass the test when the correct answer is never allowed to be a choice?

### **Question # 5**

Please select either answer A or B to any of the following questions. If you choose answer B, go to the next question. Once you have freely chosen answer A to any of the questions, you have answered correctly and the learning process is over. You are free to go directly to Level #1, Heaven, or do whatever you wish. Have fun and don't make yourself wrong or beat up on yourself if you have chosen answer B. If you do choose answer B, just experience it as long as you want and when you decide you no longer want the experience, go to the next question. Spend as long as you want on any B answer and then go to the next question and simply choose again.

I will be happy when

The list of questions is endless because it is the choice for the truth or the choice for fantasy. It is a choice between the egoic thought system or the Holy Spirit's. It is a choice between denying or accepting the Atonement for yourself.

You are free to make up as many B answers as you wish to experience. You are the creator of your own experience but, ultimately you will freely decide to return to the truth because you cannot change what you are. You can deny the truth but your denial cannot change the truth. God's Will is that you be happy. You cannot be happy unless you are

free. This means you are free to be or imagine anything you want. Ultimately, however, being created a Oneness of All That Is, you cannot be content with littleness. Answer A is always the same and always offered with each question because it is the only correct answer for the truth. Without providing option A as a possible answer to the question, you would not be given free will. To choose only between two wrong answers is not a free choice. To have free will, you must have the choice to choose between the truth or the false. ACIM states in the Introduction “Free will does not mean that you can establish the curriculum. It means only that you can elect what to take at a given time.” The curriculum must return you to the truth of what you are. Ultimately you will freely choose to take the class that is described by Answer A. Answer A is “I accept the truth that I am as God created me, perfect, whole and complete.” Answer A is the acceptance of the Atonement for oneself.

**Discussion:** Does Question #5 give you the feeling that God loves you? This is God’s solution or answer to our question, “What would it be like to be something other than as God created me?” God allows his child the freedom to explore any possibilities in perfect safety. God does not make the child wrong over the child’s choice of toys. God only asks the child to choose again after he or she has tired of playing with that toy.
